FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

(By Plaintiff Against All Defendants For Assault and Battery)

1. The true names and/or capacities of defendants Does 1 through 50, Inclusive and/or the facts sufficient to constitute a cause of action of and/or against said fictitiously named defendants, are unknown to plaintiff at this time. Plaintiff therefore sues said defendants by said fictitious names and will ask leave of Court to amend this complaint to show the true names and/or capacities and/or facts sufficient to constitute a cause of action when the same are ascertained. 1 defendants are sued as principals and/or agents, servants and employees of said principals, and all
2 the facts performed by them as agents, servants and employees were performed within the course and
3 scope of their authority and employment. Each of the fictitiously named defendants is negligently
4 or tortiously responsible in some manner for the occurrences and damages herein alleged, and
5 plaintiff's losses and damages as alleged herein, were proximately caused thereby.

6 2. Plaintiff Rose Glass is a resident of the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

7 3. Defendant American Airlines, Inc. is a Delaware corporation with its principal place
8 of business in Fort Worth, Texas. American Airlines, Inc., operates a major airline business known
9 as American Airlines throughout the United States and internationally, as a common carrier
10 transporting passengers for hire. As such a common carrier, American Airlines, Inc. had the highest
11 duty of care with respect to the safety and well-being of its passengers, including the plaintiff.

12 4. Plaintiff booked a round-trip ticket from Los Angeles, California, to Philadelphia,
13 Pennsylvania and return to Los Angeles. On or about December 15, 2016, plaintiff, an elderly
14 woman, boarded the plane for the return trip to Los Angeles with her adult daughter Lillian Glass.
15 An employee of American Airlines, despite being told by Lillian Glass, the daughter of Rose Glass,
16 that her elderly mother, Rose Glass, should not be moved, lifted Rose Glass from her own
17 wheelchair without permission, and then dropped her on the floor of the airplane.

18 5. Such physical lifting of the plaintiff and then dropping her by American Airlines and
19 its employee constituted an assault and battery to the plaintiff.

20 6. As a direct and proximate result of such tortious conduct, plaintiff has suffered and
21 will suffer the following injuries and damages:

- 22 (1) General damages to her person, according to proof;
- 23 (2) Medical and related expenses, according to proof;
- 24 (3) Miscellaneous and other damages, according to proof; and
- 25 (4) Interest according to law, according to proof.

26 7. The said conduct on the part of defendants was intentional, malicious and oppressive
27 and plaintiff is therefore entitled to punitive damages, according to proof.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

(By plaintiff against all defendants for negligence)

8. Plaintiff repeats and realleges each and every allegation contained in paragraphs 1 through 4 and 6 of the first cause of action.

9. Defendants were negligent in the handling of plaintiff, in lifting her up without permission and despite being told not to do so, and in the matter in which the plaintiff was lifted, in dropping the plaintiff and generally in dealing with the plaintiff as a passenger. Plaintiff further breached its high duty of care as a common carrier with respect to the plaintiff.

10. As a direct and proximate result of such negligence, plaintiff has suffered and will suffer damages as aforesaid.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays for damages against defendants and each of them, for the following:

- (1) General damages to her person, according to proof;
- (2) Medical and related expenses, according to proof;
- (3) Miscellaneous and other damages, according to proof;
- (4) Interest according to law, according to proof; and
- (5) Plaintiff's costs of suit, according to proof.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, plaintiff limits all claims and amounts sought hereunder to \$75,000, exclusive of interest and costs.
