Having considered Plaintiff the People of the State of California's (The People) Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, Defendant's opposition, the People's reply, and ^{extensive} oral argument, the court ORDERS that the People's Motion is GRANTED.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. During the pendency of this action, Defendant is hereby enjoined and restrained from ~~classifying its Full-Service Shopper employees in California as independent contractors in violation of California law.~~

2. ~~Defendant is further enjoined and restrained from hiring additional Full-Service Shoppers as independent contractors, including requiring Shoppers to sign Defendant's Independent Contractor Agreement.~~


3. ~~Defendant is further enjoined and restrained from failing to comply with California law with regard to its Full-Service Shopper employees, including but not limited to employment~~ within the City of San Diego.

1 ~~the Wage Orders of the Industrial Welfare Commission relating to reimbursement for expenses,~~
2 ~~overtime pay, minimum wage, and meal and rest breaks.~~

3 4. ~~Defendant is further ordered to cooperate with the City Attorney's Office to~~
4 ~~ensure compliance with this Injunction, including but not limited to, sending relevant data~~
5 ~~regarding the hours worked and amounts paid to its Full-Service Shopper employees in~~
6 ~~California.~~

7 This Injunction shall be effective as of the date it is issued, and shall remain in effect
8 through and including the trial of this matter, or ~~other such disposition~~ upon further order of this
9 Court. *Enforcement of this injunction is hereby*
10 *stayed for 10 days pursuant to CCP § 918.*
