**ORDER GRANTING JOINT
STIPULATION CLARIFYING THE
SUMMARY JUDGMENT RECORD
[230]**

1 Having considered the Joint Stipulation to Correct the Summary Judgment
2 Record filed by Plaintiffs Alex Morgan, et al. and Defendant United States Soccer
3 Federation, Inc., the Court takes notice of the Parties' Joint Stipulation that:

- 4 (1) Defendant does not intend to rely on the arguments on Page 13, Line 15
5 through Page 14, Line 12 of its Motion for Summary Judgment (Dkt. No.
6 171-1); and Page 11, Line 3 through Page 14, Line 5 of its Opposition to
7 Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment (Dkt. No. 186) and such
8 arguments need not be considered by the Court for purposes of ruling on the
9 parties' summary judgment motions;
- 10 (2) Defendant does not intend to rely on Fact Nos. 64 and 65 in its Statement of
11 Uncontroverted Facts and Conclusions of Law (Dkt. No. 171-2), which need
12 not be considered by the Court for purposes of ruling on the Parties'
13 summary judgment motions;
- 14 (3) Defendant does not dispute Fact No. 25 in Plaintiffs' Statement of
15 Uncontroverted Facts;
- 16 (4) The Parties agree that the above arguments and facts are the only ones at
17 issue in this stipulation and that the Court may consider and rule upon all
18 other arguments and facts presented in the Parties' pleadings; and
- 19 (5) The Parties further agree that Defendant reserves the right to pursue any and
20 all other factual and legal arguments at any trial of this matter outside of the
21 particular facts and arguments specifically referenced in paragraphs 1 and 2
22 above.
